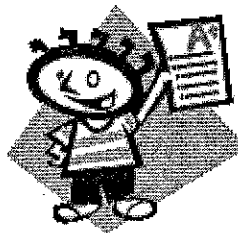

**RE: VISION SCREENING  
ON KINDERGARTEN NEW ENTRANTS**

Children entering Kindergarten are required to have a vision screening or an eye examination **PRIOR** to entering school in accordance with Michigan House Bill 5094.

**WHEN:** The child's vision screening or eye examination must have taken place **AFTER the age of three (3) and by the first day of school.**

**BY WHO:** A vision screening may be performed by a licensed medical or osteopathic physician, or by a BCHD Vision Technician. Optometrists and Ophthalmologists may perform either an eye examination or a vision screening.

**DOCUMENTATION:**

The parent should provide to the school one of the following:

- The green physical form which has a section on the back to be completed by the physician or screener, or
- A letter or statement from an eye doctor, or
- A preschool vision screening form from a Berrien County Health Department (BCHD) Vision Technician, or
- Headstart children will sometimes have a form that indicates they have had a visual screening done by either a Vision Technician or a Doctor.
