Backpack With a zipper closure – large enough for 8½ x 11 papers & larger sized library books

NO BACKPACKS WITH WHEELS, PLEASE

**Gym Shoes** 1 pair of clean, well-fitting gym shoes – to be left at school for Physical Education

**Crayons** 2 boxes of 24-count Crayola Crayons (no larger please, because of limited storage space).

Please send one new box of 24 crayons each semester.

Markers Any box of 8 washable Crayola Markers. This brand has more vibrant colors and they last longer.

Pencils (4 or 5 per month) Pencils with regular erasers, and NO pencil toppers. Please ration out 1 pencil

every week. An all-wooden pencil is required.

**Erasers** 2 large <u>white</u> erasers (the pink ones tear up the writing paper & leaves marks)

**Scissors** 1 pair – blunt-tip type is preferred.

**Highlighters** 1 <u>yellow</u> highlighter (per semester)

**Pencil Box** 1 - no larger than about 9" by 6".

Glue Sticks 2 washable glue sticks - the "colored & dries clear" type is fine

Classroom Health & 1 large box of Kleenex

Wellness 2 containers of Clorox Wipes

**Technology** 1 set of headphones [smaller sized] or earbuds – for use with technology within classroom

**Ruler** 1 clear plastic (or lightly tinted) ruler – with both inches & centimeters

**BOYS:** 1 box Sandwich-size Ziploc baggies

1 package paper plates

**GIRLS:** 1 box Gallon-size Ziploc baggies

1 package paper napkins
