Bridgman to destroy paper records

Bridgman Public Schools plans to destroy special education records for those students who received services prior to 2011.

According to the State of Michigan Records Management Services, schools are required to maintain files for the active years plus three years and individual education program records from the creation date for six years.

Students, parents or legal guardians who desire to review the records or obtain a copy prior to destruction, should contact Lee Stults at 269-466-0271. Unless contacted, these records will be destroyed June 1, 2018.

Students will need to bring a photo ID. Parents will need to bring their picture ID and have a letter signed by the student with a copy of the student's picture ID.
