USA Diving Coach Certified.

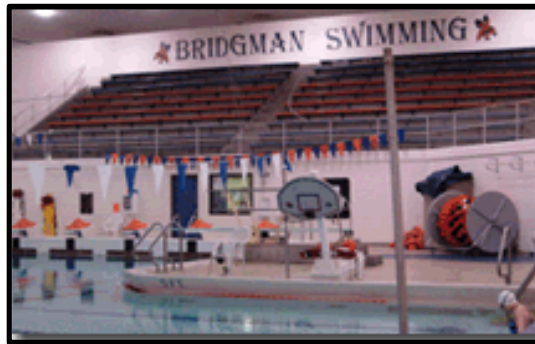
