Data Story Name: Bridgman Public Schools Literacy

Initial Data Analysis: Overall scores are remaining steady across multiple years of MStep, SAT and AimsWeb (growth) for students below the 30th percentile. Data sources (KRA, IRIP, AimsWeb) indicate areas of challenge in foundational skills (phonemic awareness, phonological awareness, and decoding), including social and early literacy skills (comprehension & vocabulary). At-risk students were out-performed by students who were not at risk.

Initial Initiative Inventory and Analysis: The focus on literacy at Bridgman Public Schools connects to our mission statement of "We provide resources to inspire resilient and collaborative thinkers". The teaching and paraprofessional staff is dedicated to provide the best literacy instruction to fit the needs of all students. Training in the science of reading is provided for teachers and paraprofessionals in grades Pro5-4. Data indicates that students who are provided with interventions grow at a pace in order to close the reading gap with their peers. The support of literacy is a priority for the administration, and assistance and

financial support is given in order to reach our literacy goals. Funding comes from Title 1, Early Literacy Grant, and the district general budget.

Gap Analysis: Our district data indicates that student growth in the elementary has remained the same in the bottom 30% of students literacy achievement as measured by the M-Step and AimsWeb. There has been growth at both the middle and high school. Analysis of subgroup data within our district (Student with Disabilities (SWD), ELL & African American (AA) students) demonstrates a significant gap between all students' proficiency and the students who are at-risk..

The 2024 district goal for literacy is to have all students improve their reading skills and proficiency levels on standardized assessments. This includes the M-Step, AimsWeb, PSAT and the SAT.

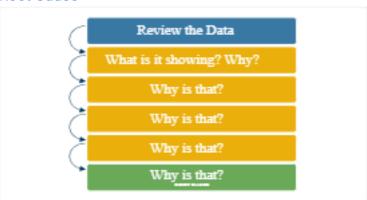
Phonemic awareness, phonological awareness, & decoding are the most common deficiencies in grades k-2

Comprehension and vocabulary are common deficiencies in grades 2-3.

*District Data Story Summary:* Students who are in the lowest 30th percentile on standardized assessments are below district expectations in literacy. There are significant gaps for at-risk students.

#### Root Cause



#### Five Whys

 Why: The 5 whys was completed in order to analze the root cause of the discrepancy between students with and without disabilities. It was determined students in the bottom thirty percentile are lacking foundational literacy skills. Some students lack



foundational literacy skills due to learning disabilities. Learning disabilities are not being diagnosed at an early age in order to receive proper literacy instruction that meets their needs. Literacy instruction is not providing enough opportunities for students to increase their reading capabilities.

Challenge Statement: If at-risk students from the demographic subgroups were provided with literacy intervention and increased support, then students will demonstrate measurable skills in reading.
