If you failed any 9th, 10th or 11th grade required courses it is recommended you take summer school or enroll in RTI. If you don't, you may jeopardize graduation. The counseling office will work to schedule you into the failed courses if you do not recover credit through summer school.

1. Go to <http://bridgmanpowerschool.berrienresa.org/public/home.html>.
2. Enter your Username and Password, then click “Sign In.”
3. Select “Class Registration” from the options listed on the left hand side of the screen.
4. Please select the courses, you want to take by following the instructions listed on the screen. Click “Submit” when you are done selecting courses.
5. Print that page. You should have enough classes to fill 6 yearlong courses. Please be aware that semester courses need to be paired with each other, so they are equivalent to a yearlong course.
6. If you are interested in a CTE program, please select 6 BHS courses and then, see Mrs. Haskins or Ms. Mcgee to register for the CTE program.
7. If you are interested in dual enrollment, please select 6 BHS courses and see Mrs. Haskins.
8. Have your parent sign at the bottom of the print screen.
9. Return the Print Screen to the BHS office by **3/4**.
